AAR EMIS ABT UPLOAD PROCEDURES for tests performed by Members on any car

1. A person and/or shop desiring to use the RPCA Member Benefit to upload Single Car Test (SCT) Air Brake Test (ABT) information to the Umler/EMIS file must be and remain a Railroad Passenger Car Alliance (RPCA) member in good standing, and shall have executed and filed the ABT Agreement with Railroad Passenger Car Numbering Bureau (RPCNB).
2. A person and/or shop desiring to use the ABT SCT upload benefit must provide the RPCNB with data showing the air technician's certification prior to the uploading on any air dates. At the very least this should be a photocopy of both sides of the certification card assigned to the technician. Preferably this information is a diploma or other similar document identifying the authority conferring the certification and the technician.
3. To upload ABT SCT successful air test dates per the AAR Umler Data Specification Manual, the certified air technician person and/or shop employing such certified air technician person shall provide by email of the following data within 24 hours of test:
 - Shop name (if shop)
 - Shop Code or RR reporting mark shop owned by
 - Certified Air Technician Name / ID # or code
 - Car Owner (company or person's name)
 - Car Reporting Mark and Number
 - Car Name (if named)
 - Brake Schedule (U12BD, 26C8, etc.)
 - SPLC where test completed or city/state name where test completed
 - Date of successful test
 - Certified Air Technicians SIGNATURE
 - Who should be invoiced (CAT or Car Owner)
4. The information identified in item 3. above shall be sent by e-mail to:

5. Payment of the current rate (see fee page at rpcnb.com) for ABT update is required to happen before ABT will be entered into UMLER.
